## Discovery Education Assessment: Early Skills Whole Group Testing Identifies Literacy Deficiencies

Discovery Education Assessment: Early Skills is a K-2 assessment tool that measures the literacy skills identified by the National Reading Panel and the National Mathematics Council and helps prepare students for future success. Educators can continually monitor and assess the basic reading and math literacy of students and measure a full range of reading skills, including:

- » Phonemic Awareness
- » Phonics
- » Vocabulary
- » Comprehension (Listening/Reading)

Discovery Education Assessment: Early Skills evaluates individual student development and identifies poorly developing skills before students are put at risk for persistent academic underachievement.

Reports allow educators to quickly and easily identify mastered, partially-mastered, or non-mastered reading and math skills, enabling educators to readjust instruction to fit the needs of each individual student.

- Provides measures of comprehension and fluency that directly affect future success of independent learners.
- Measures four of the five literacy skills identified by the National Reading Panel and the concerns identified by the National Mathematics Council.
- Administered printed or online (including an option) that reads the assessment aloud to the student as appropriate.)
- Presents teachers and parents with clear and easily understood reports on student skill level and progress.
- Taken in group setting and offers flexible administration options that free educators from time-consuming, oneon-one testing—multiple choice, with no teacher scoring.
